Greets Residents

I hope you all have had a great fall so far.

The city council met on their regular monthly meeting on October the 5th. Some items that were discussed were: the final pool numbers for the year. The pool was more efficient from the water, chemical and heat side of things as well as attendance was up despite being open later in the year. The city decided on a bid to remove the asbestos in the old school. This is the first step in the demolition of the old building. The council also approved two cameras to be put at city hall to monitor the outside of the build. There was also a call from the DNR in regards to our waste water lagoon. We currently are discharging more water than our facility is supposed to process. We have fixed a water leak as actively finding some other trouble areas of extra water flowing outside of town. We do not need to add anything to our lagoon at this time. Lastly our next council meeting will be at the Community Center on Nov 2nd at 6:30pm. We are moving the meeting so all are welcome, and people can sit at a comfortable distance from one another.

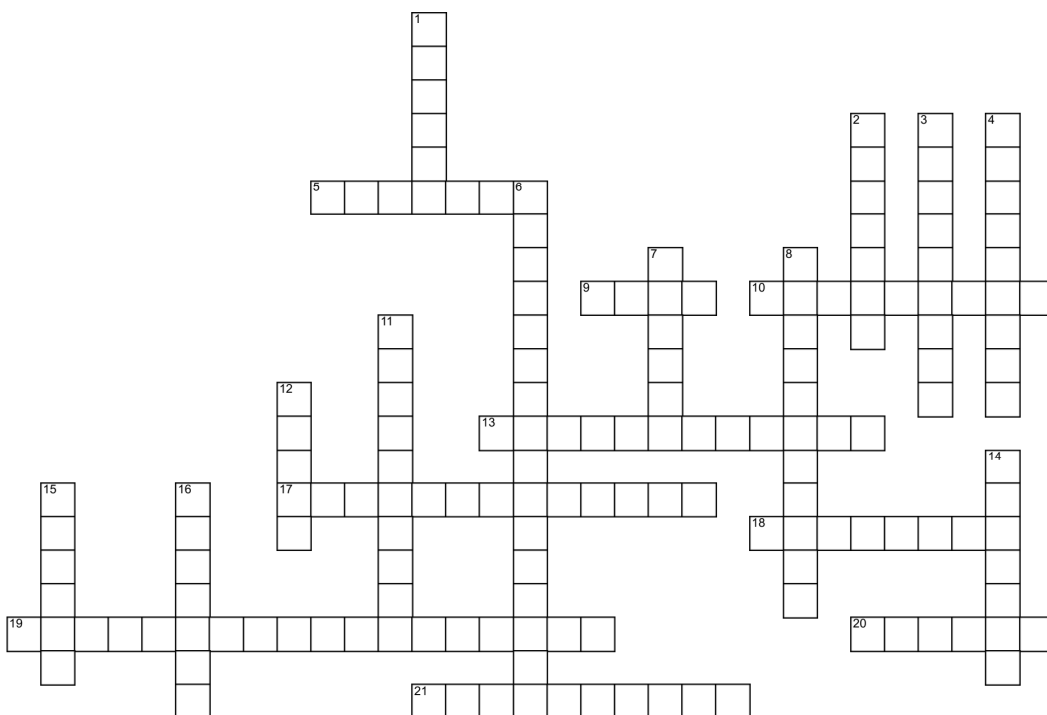
